18 arrested in Arundel on outstanding warrants

The Anne Arundel County Sheriff's Office said Monday that 18 people were arrested and 23 warrants were cleared over the Independence Day weekend. The sheriff's emergency response team and a police dog conducted the warrant sweep Friday in southern Anne Arundel County. Information received during the sweep also led to the arrest Saturday of a suspect wanted for first-degree assault, the sheriff's office said. Others arrested during the sweep were wanted on charges including assault, theft, failing to register as a sex offender, traffic violations, violation of probation and violation of community detention. Two juveniles were among those arrested.
