Man charged with shooting at deputy

ARNOLD — A man was charged yesterday with shooting at a county Sheriff's Office sergeant who was attempting to serve a warrant on the man's daughter, authorities said.

Sgt. Carl Schanberger pulled up to 987 Shore Acres Road at about 7:50 a.m. to serve a warrant on Lauren A. Divine, 22.

When he drove up to the home, Divine's father, 61-year-old Rodney Divine, shot a .45-caliber handgun at the sergeant, striking his vehicle, authorities said. Schanberger was not injured.

Deputy Sheriff Gary White Sr. ordered Divine to drop his weapon. Divine put the gun down and was arrested by sheriff's deputies without further incident.

He was charged with attempted second-degree murder, first-degree assault and reckless endangerment.

He is being held at the Jennifer Road Detention Center in Parole on \$500,000 bond, according to electronic court records.
